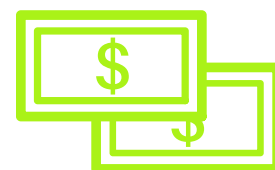

Serving Dodge, Fillmore, Freeborn, Goodhue, Houston, Mower, Olmsted, Rice, Steele, Wabasha, and Winona counties and is affiliated with the SELCO regional public library system.

Southeast Library System (SELS) fosters collaboration, communication, training, and the sharing of resources among its members by:

- Managing a variety of technology services that includes operating the regional integrated library system for the resource sharing of over 3.5 million items.
- Providing delivery among libraries and handling approximately 3,500 items daily.
- Licensing a variety of electronic resources to supplement conventional library materials and free online sources.
- Providing continuing education opportunities to library staff, trustees, and library volunteers.
- Offering professional development scholarships for all
- Supporting library programs for library patrons of all ages, as well as support Library Legacy activities through Minnesota's unique Arts and Cultural Heritage Fund.
- Undertaking grant writing to bring new projects and ideas to fruition within the region.
- Offering a school media center specific eBook program through MackinVIA
